Below is a list of several of these items that we feel most critical currently. We realize there has been some different interpretations of essential key personnel for the facilities. The US Department of Homeland Security issued a memorandum on March 19, 2020 that clearly defines the key personnel for Healthcare entities. The link for this memorandum is attached:
